Serve as a Christian role model as you journey with candidates toward Confirmation, particularly through co-leading a small group on a regular basis. Must participate in all trainings, meetings, and leader retreat. Applications required; will email details. Must be confirmed and in 11th grade or above.

Serve as the youth minister's assistant in admin/logistics i.e. help leaders get materials, troubleshoot technology issues (training provided) make copies, monitor facilities, address behavior issues, etc.
