Pastor's Update -Incredible Festival was very successful. Announced at the festival that the \$3.1M goal was reached for the Capital Campaign. Rededication of the refurbished Bell Tower was held on the Sunday of the festival.

Archdiocese is working on Synod 2021 and is seeking input from lay faithful. Twenty different listening sessions are being held throughout the Archdiocese.

Liaison reports:

- Finance - Upcoming meeting, with Campaign Financial Oversight sub-committee reporting.
- Liturgy - Working on Advent Evening Prayer service and will be getting new Advent cards.
- Maintenance - Repair work on the church terrazzo floors should start on September 30. Working with an electrician to get an idea of what needs to be done for the wiring for the school.
- School - MAP Growth Assessments will start on Sept 23. Students will be assessed in Reading, LA Usage, Science, and Math. Teachers will use this data to plan lessons for each student. Planning is underway for the Oct. 25th Rake-A-Thon, with a goal this year of \$29,000. Spaghetti dinner will be on Oct. 24. Enrollment is currently 123 students.
- Stewardship - The Ministry Fair will be held October 5-6
- Westonka Food Shelf - Shelly Sir has put in her resignation as of Oct 1. Michelle Bottenfield is set to take over her position. Bob Christians will be in charge of communications.
