**Pastor's Update** - With the current difficult circumstances due to the Coronavirus, we will try to have a drive-in Mass. The announcement was made that Fr. Tony will be leaving OLL and will become the pastor of St. John Neumann parish in Eagan, as well as the canonical administrator of Faithful Shepherd Catholic School in Eagan. Fr. Peter Richards will be our new pastor.

**Liaison reports:**

- CCW - Currently at a standstill. Will be electing new board members when they meet again
- Finance - Held a Zoom Meeting. Agreed that all capital campaign projects are on hold for now.
- PennyWise- They will be getting together soon to decide what to do with re-opening.
- Scouts - Troop 571 has been busy - they conducted a Zoom Board of Review for Eagle Reviews Charlie Nelson and Dylan McManus. The scouts are pursuing many online Merit Badges with one female Scout earning over 15 badges.
- Stewardship - Met last week and discussed postponing the upcoming Welcome Brunch.
- Westonka Food Shelf- Reconfigured shift teams to make way for family teams. The Food Shelf is getting free milk via a federal program. March Food Totals to Patrons: 60,000 lbs. 22 new patron families were added in March.
